I. BACKGROUND

The Division of Medical Assistance and the Division of Social Services issued instructions for Managed Care Waiver Tracking. These instructions are found in DMA Administrative Letter No. 28-01, DSS Administrative Letter No. 09-01 (Economic Independence/Work First), and DSS Administrative Letter No. 03-2001 (Adult and Family Services).

The purpose of this administrative letter is to notify counties of changes in the above noted letter.

II. CHANGES

Effective Monday, January 7, 2002, Mecklenburg County will be converted to a dual Carolina ACCESS/HMO county. Due to these changes, please note the following:

- A. Carolina ACCESS only counties continue to follow Attachment 1 in DMA Administrative Letter 28-01.
- B. Obsolete Attachment 2 in DMA Administrative Letter 28-01.
- C. Any dual Carolina ACCESS/HMO county <u>must</u> follow Attachment 3 in DMA Administrative Letter 28-01.

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All other policy in DMA Administrative Letter No. 28-01, DSS Administrative Letter No. 09-01 (Economic Independence/Work First), and DSS Administrative Letter No. 03-2001 (Adult and Family Services) is still in effect.
