MEDICAID DEDUCTIBLES – AGED, BLIND AND DISABLED COURSE NAME = DEDUCT

This course covers Medicaid deductibles as they apply to Aged, Blind and Disabled Medicaid policy. Before enrolling in this course, the student must have a basic knowledge of Medicaid eligibility and preferably have experience in the calculation of countable monthly income. We suggest that new MAABD workers, and veteran workers who need a refresher on deductible policy, enroll in this course.

The course takes approximately 9 hours to complete.
