The purpose of this letter is to provide the 2018 Federal Poverty Levels (FPL) income limits to be used when determining eligibility for Presumptively Eligible Pregnant Women. These limits are effective April 1, 2018.

- B. Use the <u>Integrated Eligibility Manual (IEM) section 4200</u>, Federal Poverty Level income limits in effect April 1, 2017 for applications taken prior to April 1, 2018.
- B. Use the <u>Integrated Eligibility Manual (IEM) section 4200</u>, Federal Poverty Level income limits in effect April 1, 2018 for applications taken on or after April 1, 2018.
