

# CHANGE NOTICE FOR MANUAL NO. 05-04, NOTICE AND HEARING PROCEDURES

## **I. BACKGROUND**

The purpose of this change notice is to clarify that an adequate notice may only be used when an applicant/recipient requests termination of Medicaid in writing.

## **II. CONTENT OF CHANGE**

MA-2420, Notice and Hearings Process, has been revised to inform workers that only a recipient's written request can be accepted before adequately terminating or reducing any Medicaid aid/program category.

## **III. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This change in policy is effective October 1, 2003. Apply to all requests for termination taken on or after October 1, 2003.
